Fiction 4 weeks

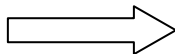
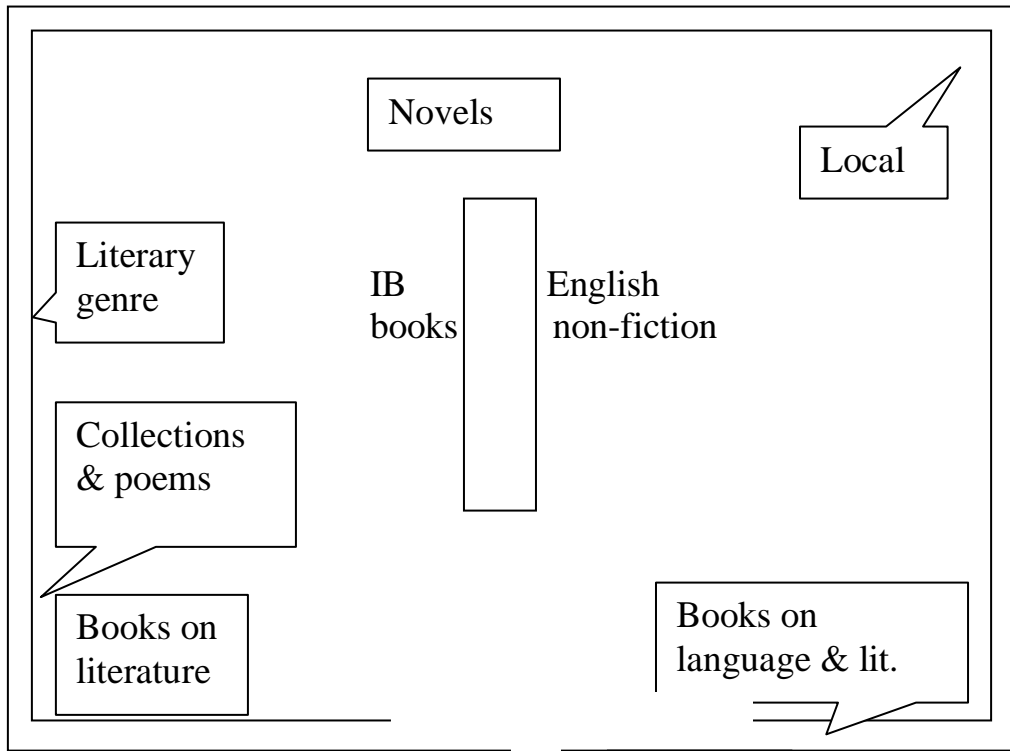

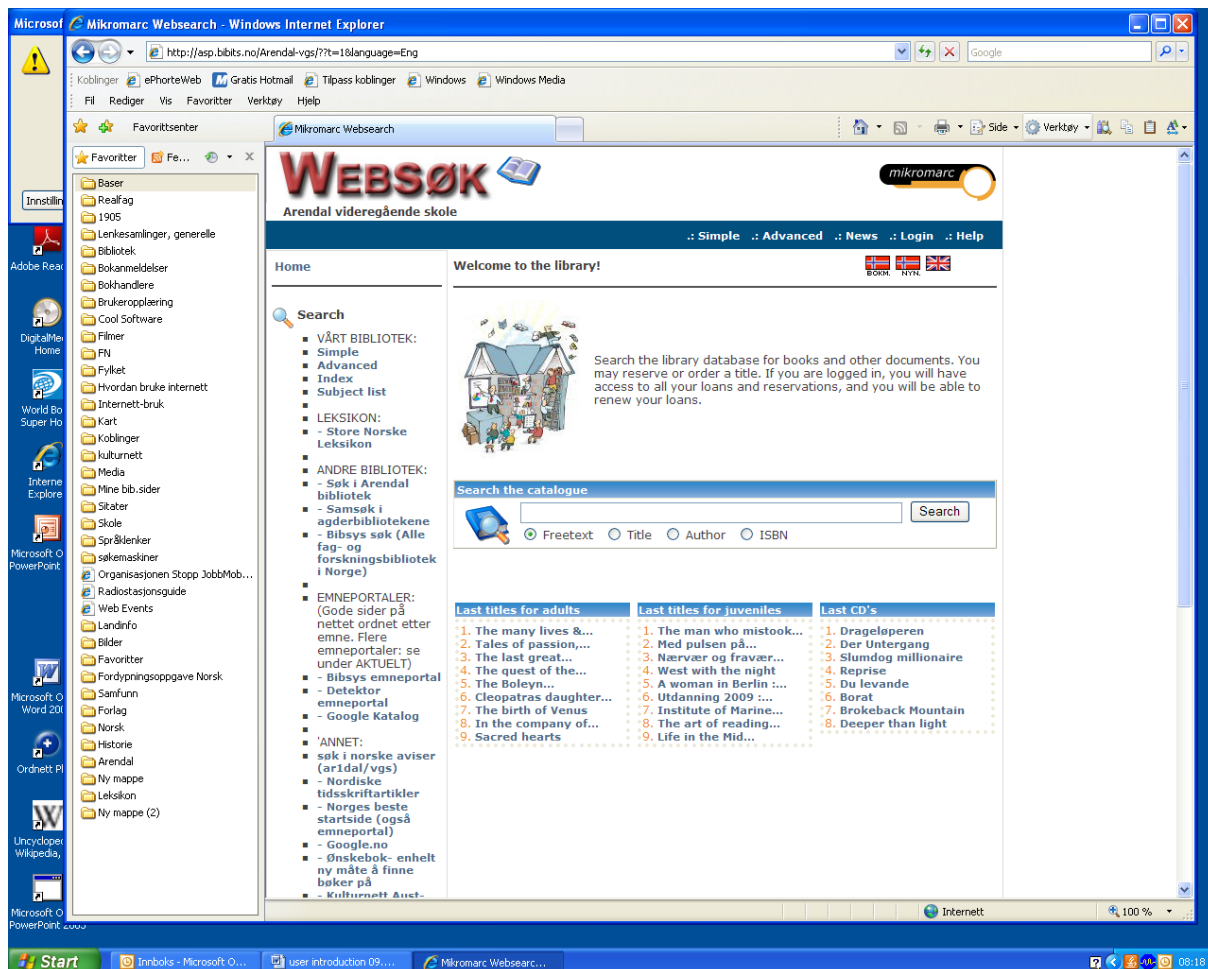


Search the school-librarys database :

English version: click the English flag at the top
(not very good in English yet)



If you choose advanced search (left) you can specify your search. Use the pop-up menus

- If you look for **English fiction books**

choose "skjønnlitteraturkode" and write **1***
and "språkkode" and write **eng**

- If you look for **English non-fiction books**

choose "skjønnlitteraturkode" and write **0***
and "språkkode" and write **eng**

On the left you find links to other libraries, directories etc, but as of now the texts are in Norwegian.

To get books/ publications from other libraries:

Get yourself a LIBRARY CARD called NORGESKORTET at the nearest Public library.

- Ask for a Pin-code

You also need an E-mail address

Theoretically, you can then borrow via Internet, from any public library or university/research institution, anywhere in Norway when you have this library card, but it's not easy.

Ask the school librarian for help.
